

Life Defense Fund Citizen Education

- Stand next to petition circulators.
- Give citizens our handout explaining the extreme nature of the Abortion Constitutional Amendment.
- Encourage citizens not to sign the petition.

What to Do and Say:

- 1. Arrive at location to distribute handouts next to a circulator.
- Hand the citizen the handout as you say, "Hello, please decline to sign that abortion
 petition. It legalizes even late term abortion up to the point of birth in our state
 Constitution. It's too extreme."
- 3. Rely upon the "Decline to Sign" handout. If citizens ask more questions about what the amendment does, rely on the 4 points on the back side of the handout.

Do Not Engage in the Following:

- 1. Touching, cornering, obstructing, or coercing petition circulators or the general public;
- 2. Disorderly conduct or the use of offensive or abusive language;
- 3. Follow circulators to multiple locations;
- 4. Fighting or threatening violence while volunteering;
- 5. Sexual or other unlawful or unwelcome harassment;
- 6. Engage petition circulators or media in conversation—our goal is to educate the public, not to debate the circulators or media;
- 7. Unauthorized disclosure of any confidential information;
- 8. Theft or inappropriate removal of property;
- 9. Volunteering under the influence of alcohol.
